1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Government Regulations be
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the
3 purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject of the
4 House document numbered: — H. 6309 legislation relative to the
5 rules pertaining to certain plumbing and gas fitting regulations.
6 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State
7 House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within
8 the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services
9 and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefore. Said
10 committee shall report to the General Court the results of its
11 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
12 with drafts of such legislation necessary to carry such recommenda-
13 tions into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of the House on or
14 before the last Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and
15 eighty-six.
