AN ACT

To authorize the City of Taunton to discontinue
a Part of the Caswell Burial Ground.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Taunton may discon-
2 tinue for use as a burial ground such part of the
3 Caswell lot, so called, owned by it and lying on
4 the southerly side of Middleboro avenue in said
5 city, as is not now occupied by graves or lots,
6 and may use for school purposes the said part
7 so discontinued: *provided, however,* that nothing
8 herein contained shall be deemed to authorize
9 the use of said lot contrary to any restrictions
10 thereon without the consent of the heirs or legal
11 representatives of Cyrus Caswell and Julia Fair-
12 banks, under whose deeds the city holds title to
13 the said land.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
