To accompany the petition of the Federation of State, City and Town Employees, that provision be made for a Saturday half holiday for certain public employees. Cities.

AN ACT

To provide a Saturday Half Holiday for Certain State, County and Municipal Employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All laborers, workmen and mechanics employed
2 in any capacity by the commonwealth or by any
3 county, city or town, whose services can be dis-
4 pensed with, shall be given a half holiday on every
5 Saturday in the year, without loss of pay. In
6 case the services of any such employee cannot be
7 dispensed with on any Saturday as aforesaid, he
8 shall, in every case, be given a half holiday with-
9 out loss of pay on some other working day.

AN ACT

To provide a better method of electing members of the Commission of Government and to provide for the removal of members thereof and for the appointment of members thereof.
