To accompany the petition of James C. Blake and another that the city of Worcester be authorized to pension Walter F. Gleason. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-One.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Worcester to pension
Walter F. Gleason.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Worcester is hereby
2 authorized to pay to Walter F. Gleason, who
3 after a service of more than twenty years in the
4 employ of the city as an inspector in the street
5 department, retired on account of permanent
6 physical disability in nineteen hundred and
7 twenty, an annual pension of five hundred and
8 twenty dollars, payable monthly.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said
3 city, subject to the provisions of its charter, pro-
4 vided such acceptance occurs prior to the thirty-
5 first day of December in the current year.
