AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATIONS AT SPECIAL TOWN MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 39 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by chapter 152 of the acts of 1949, is hereby
3 further amended by adding at the end the following
4 sentence:— No appropriation at any special town
5 meeting shall be valid unless at least two thirds of
6 those voting are in favor of the appropriation.
