Department of the Interior

It is the policy of the Government of Canada to encourage the settlement of the West and to assist in the development of the resources of the West. To this end, the Government has established the Department of the Interior, which is responsible for the management of the public lands and the promotion of the settlement of the West.

The Department of the Interior is organized into several branches, each of which is responsible for a specific aspect of the Department's work. These branches are the Bureau of Land Management, the Bureau of Geology, the Bureau of Forestry, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The Bureau of Land Management is responsible for the management of the public lands and for the promotion of the settlement of the West. It is also responsible for the management of the public forests and for the promotion of the development of the resources of the West.
