AN ACT REQUIRING THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT
ON CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF GAS BY THE
BOSTON CONSOLIDATED GAS COMPANY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 417 of the acts of 1903 is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 6 and inserting in place thereof
3 the following section:—

4 *Section 6.* Said Boston Consolidated Gas Com-
5 pany shall not contract for the purchase of any gas
6 for a period of more than thirty days without having
7 first obtained the approval of the department of public
8 utilities. The said department may from time to time
9 determine the period or periods during which said
10 company may so purchase its gas at the price afore-
11 said. No contract which the Boston Consolidated
12 Gas Company shall make for the purchase of any
13 portion of its gas shall in any respect affect any au-
14 thority previously or hereafter conferred on said de-
15 partment to fix the price to be charged by said com-
16 pany for gas.
