The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT FURTHER TO REGULATE THE TRANSFER OF CERTIFICATES ISSUED FOR CERTAIN COMMON CARRIERS OF PASSENGERS BY MOTOR VEHICLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7A of chapter 159A of the General Laws,
2 as inserted by chapter 449 of the acts of 1949, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "person" in line
4 4, the words:— any associated group of persons or
5 any, — so that the first sentence of the second para-
6 graph will read as follows:— No person, firm, trust
7 or corporation subject to the jurisdiction of the de-
8 partment shall hereafter purchase, acquire, take or
9 hold, directly or indirectly, any part of the capital
10 stock of any carrier subject to the provisions of this
11 chapter, nor shall any person, any associated group
12 of persons or any firm, trust or corporation, who or
13 which is not subject to the jurisdiction of the depart-
14 ment, acquire, take or hold, directly or indirectly,
15 more than fifty per cent of the voting capital stock of
16 a carrier subject to this chapter, unless authorized so
17 to do by the department.
