AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF OVERTIME TO
STATE EMPLOYEES UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 Every employee of the commonwealth called out
2 by his supervisor to do emergency work shall be
3 paid a minimum of three hours' overtime pay at his
4 regular rate of compensation.
- 5 All service rendered by an employee of the com-
6 monwealth at the request of the appointing officer
7 in excess of eight hours in any one day, providing
8 the total service rendered by the employee is equal
9 to or greater than forty hours in any one week, and
10 all service rendered by an employee of the common-
11 wealth at the request of the appointing officer in
12 excess of forty hours in any one week, shall be com-
13 pensated at time and one half the regular rate of
14 compensation.
