AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE MINIMUM SALARY FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 40 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 684 of the acts
3 of 1949, is hereby amended by striking out the first
4 sentence of said section and inserting in place thereof
5 the following: — The compensation of every teacher
6 employed in any public day school in the common-
7 wealth, except persons in training and those em-
8 ployed as temporary substitutes, shall be a at rate
9 of not less than twenty-three hundred dollars in
10 towns of less than two and one half million dollars
11 valuation for the fiscal year preceding and in all
12 other towns at a rate of not less than twenty-six
13 hundred dollars for the school year in that school.
