AN ACT PROVIDING FOR BUS SERVICE TO THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN CHELSEA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Metropolitan transit authority is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to establish and maintain bus
3 service to the Soldiers' Home in the city of Chelsea.

The Committee on Education, and the Committee on the Administration of the Government, have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 10th inst., and in reply to inform you that the same has been referred to the proper authorities for their consideration.

The Government of the District of Columbia

Resolved, That the following be the policy of the Government of the District of Columbia:

1. That the Government of the District of Columbia shall be organized as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Section 1. The Executive Power shall be vested in the Mayor of the District of Columbia, who shall hold his office for a term of four years, and shall be eligible for re-election.

Section 2. The Legislative Power shall be vested in the Council of the District of Columbia, which shall consist of a majority of the members of the Council of the District of Columbia, and shall be elected by the people of the District of Columbia.
