AN ACT RELATIVE TO REGULATING THE SALARY OF THE OFFICER IN THE PROBATE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30 of chapter 217 of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by adding at
3 the end the following paragraph:—

4 The officer in attendance upon the probate court
5 of the county of Essex shall receive in full for all
6 services performed by him such salary as shall be
7 fixed by the judges of said probate court.
