AN ACT EXTENDING TENURE OF OFFICE TO THE PRESENT  
INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF DOG OFFICER IN THE  
CITY OF REVERE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Ralph T. Mele, the present incumbent  
2 of the office of dog officer in the city of Revere, is  
3 hereby given unlimited tenure of office therein, and  
4 shall not be involuntarily separated from his service  
5 as such except subject to and in accordance with the  
6 provisions of sections forty-three and forty-five of  
7 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect only upon  
2 its acceptance, in the current year, by the mayor and  
3 city council of said city.
