AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE HUNTING OF HARES AND RABBITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 65 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by chapter 599 of the acts of 1941, is hereby
3 further amended by adding at the end the following
4 new sentence:— Notwithstanding the foregoing no
5 person shall hunt or have in possession the carcass of
6 a hare or rabbit at any time during the open season
7 for the hunting of deer established under the pro-
8 visions of section eighty.
