## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF UNIFORM OFFICIAL BLANKS IN CERTAIN DISTRICT COURTS OF THE COMMON- WEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 43B of chapter 218 of the General Laws,  
2 inserted by chapter 210 of the acts of 1950, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the word "fifty-one" at the  
4 end of the first sentence thereof and inserting in place  
5 thereof the word: — fifty-two, — so as to read as fol-  
6 lows: — *Section 43B.* In addition to the powers set  
7 forth in section forty-three A, the committee shall  
8 prescribe official forms to be used in all district courts,  
9 except in the county of Suffolk. Such forms and no  
10 others shall be used in said courts on and after January  
11 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-two. Forms as pre-  
12 scribed in this section shall be furnished by the coun-  
13 ties, and it shall be the duty of each clerk to notify the  
14 county commissioners of his county, on or before

15 December first of each year of the probable needs of  
16 his office for the ensuing year, including an estimate  
17 of the quantity of each then in his possession. Noth-  
18 ing in this section shall be construed as affecting the  
19 provisions of section one hundred and one A of chap-  
20 ter two hundred and seventy-six.
