### AN ACT TRANSFERRING CERTAIN PARK LAND FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PARKS OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would  
2 tend to defeat its purpose, which in part is to have its  
3 provisions become effective immediately in order that  
4 construction may be started on a fire station, there-  
5 fore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,  
6 necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
7 public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 A certain parcel of land located on Parker street in  
2 the city of Springfield, hereinafter described by metes  
3 and bounds, is hereby transferred, free of all restric-  
4 tions, from the department of public parks of said  
5 city to said city of Springfield for any purposes for

6 which a city has the power to hold and convey prop-  
7 erty, it being the intention of said city to construct  
8 thereon a fire station. Said parcel of land is bounded  
9 and described as follows: Beginning at a point in the  
10 easterly street line of Parker street, said point being  
11 south  $22^{\circ} 35' 30''$  east eighteen and twenty-five one  
12 hundredths feet from a point in the easterly street  
13 line of Parker street, as laid out by the county com-  
14 missioners on August sixteenth, nineteen hundred  
15 and thirty-three, and the south-westerly corner of  
16 Old Acre road abandoned by order of the board of  
17 aldermen of the city of Springfield on May third,  
18 nineteen hundred and forty-eight; thence south  
19  $22^{\circ} 35' 30''$  east along the southerly street line of Old  
20 Acre road abandoned a distance of twenty-two and  
21 ninety-eight one hundredths feet to a point; thence  
22 south  $22^{\circ} 43' 10''$  east along the southerly line of  
23 Old Acre road abandoned a distance of thirty and  
24 eighty-seven one hundredths feet to a point; thence  
25 south  $24^{\circ} 28' 10''$  east along the southerly street line  
26 of Old Acre road abandoned a distance of thirty and  
27 eighty-seven one hundredths feet to a point; thence  
28 south  $24^{\circ} 58' 00''$  east along the southerly street line  
29 of Old Acre road abandoned a distance of twelve and  
30 seventy-eight one hundredths feet to a point; thence  
31 north  $79^{\circ} 21' 35''$  west along other land of the city  
32 of Springfield park department a distance of fifty-  
33 seven and five one hundredths feet to a point in the  
34 easterly street line of Parker street as laid out by  
35 the board of aldermen of the city of Springfield on  
36 May third, nineteen hundred and forty-eight; thence  
37 by a curve to the left having a radius of nine hundred  
38 twenty-eight and seven hundred fifty-four one  
39 thousandths feet along the easterly street line of

40 Parker street as laid out on May third, nineteen  
41 hundred and forty-eight, an arc distance of eighty  
42 and sixty-seven one hundredths feet to the point of  
43 beginning, and containing two thousand two hundred  
44 eleven and sixty-four one hundredths square feet.
