By Mr. Armstrong of Plymouth, petition of John A. Armstrong that the Department of Public Works be authorized to construct certain retaining walls and riprap along Eel River in the town of Plymouth. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN RETAINING WALLS AND RIPRAP ALONG EEL RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to construct retaining
3 walls and such other flood and erosion control works
4 as it may deem necessary along Eel river, in the town
5 of Plymouth, beginning at a point easterly of the
6 bridge on the state highway numbered Route 3 where
7 said Eel river crosses said main highway. Said de-
8 partment may expend for such purposes such sums as
9 may hereafter be appropriated therefor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
