AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BOSTON UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, any employee of the ferry division of the public
3 works department in the city of Boston, who is em-
4 ployed either as a member of a boat crew or as a
5 maintenance worker on boats owned by said city,
6 shall be granted compensation benefits under chapter
7 one hundred and fifty-two of the General Laws if he
8 is injured while working on said boats.
