AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF AN INCINERATOR IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR USE OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct and maintain
3 an incinerator in the city of Chelsea for the use of
4 said city, at such location as said commission may
5 determine. For said purpose, said commission may
6 expend such sums as may hereafter be appropriated
7 therefor.
