
By Mr. Armstrong of Plymouth, petition of Alfred N. Gifford that the town of Plymouth be authorized to appropriate money for the annual national convention of the One Hundred and First Infantry Veterans Association. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PROVIDE FACILITIES FOR HOLDING IN SAID TOWN DURING THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY-ONE THE ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE ONE HUNDRED AND FIRST INFANTRY VETERANS ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Plymouth may appropri-
2 ate a sum, not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars,
3 for the purpose of providing proper facilities for
4 public entertainment at the time of the annual na-
5 tional convention of the One Hundred and First
6 Infantry Veterans Association, to be held in said
7 town during the year nineteen hundred and fifty-one,
8 and of paying expenses incidental to such entertain-
9 ment. Money so appropriated shall be expended
10 under the direction of the selectmen of said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
