The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT INCREASING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN RETIRED STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of law,
2 the annual retirement allowance of any former state
3 employee who has reached the age of eighty years or
4 older and has been in the state service for forty years
5 or more, is hereby increased twelve and one half per
6 cent.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year of the Lord 1880, the said Commonwealth of Massachusetts

doth enact, that the following shall be the law in that behalf made:

Section 1. That the Board of Education of the Commonwealth be and they are authorized to make and publish a list of the names of the children of the Commonwealth who are under the age of sixteen years.

Section 2. That the Board of Education of the Commonwealth be and they are authorized to make and publish a list of the names of the children of the Commonwealth who are under the age of sixteen years, and who have not been in the State since the year 1870, and who are now in the State.
