AN ACT EXTENDING THE BENEFITS OF FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY LEGISLATION TO CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The retirement board and treasurer and receiver
- 2 general shall make provision to include public em-
- 3 ployees, who are ineligible to join the state retirement
- 4 system, in the coverage of the social security system
- 5 as provided for in the amendments voted by Congress
- 6 in nineteen hundred and fifty.
