RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO PASS A FEDERAL FAIR EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES ACT WITH ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts general court,
2 assembled in session, petition the Congress of the
3 United States to pass legislation creating a federal
4 fair employment practices act with enforcement pro-
5 visions adequate to insure compliance by employers;
6 and be it further

7 *Resolved*, That copies of this resolution be sent forth-
8 with by the secretary of the commonwealth to the
9 President of the United States, to the presiding officers
10 of each branch of Congress, and to the members thereof
11 from this commonwealth.
