### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LISTING OF DOGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 150 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as

3 1934, is hereby further amended by striking out the  
4 word "assessors" where it occurs in the first and sec-  
5 ond sentences and inserting in place thereof in each  
6 instance the words: — registrars of voters, — so that

8 *Section 150.* The registrars of voters shall annually  
9 make a list of all dogs owned or kept in their respective  
10 cities and towns in January, February or March, with

12 return the same in duplicate to the city or town clerk,  
13 or, in Boston, to the police commissioner, on or before  
14 April first. An owner or keeper of a dog who refuses

18 Suffolk county, shall be paid into the county treasury.
