AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SUBSTITUTION OF NOMINEES  
FOR THE OFFICE OF REPRESENTATIVE OR SENATOR TO  
THE GENERAL COURT IF THE NOMINEE DIES BEFORE  
ELECTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Section 14 of chapter 53 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended, is hereby further amended by inserting  
3 after section 14 the following section:—  
4 *Section 14A.* Notwithstanding any provisions of  
5 law to the contrary any candidate nominated to the  
6 office of representative or senator to the general court  
7 who dies before the date of the next state election  
8 shall have his name stricken from the ballot. In place  
9 thereof there shall be inserted on the ballot the name  
10 of the candidate of the same party designation as the  
11 deceased candidate who received the largest number  
12 of votes of these candidates of such party who failed to  
13 be nominated.
