AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE COMPENSATION FOR DEATH AND INJURIES RESULTING IN DEATH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 229 of the General Laws, as amended, is
2 hereby further amended by striking out, in section 1,
3 as amended, the words "one thousand dollars" and
4 inserting in their place the words:— fifteen thousand
5 dollars, — and by striking out, in sections 2, 2A, 2C
6 and 6E, as amended, the words "two thousand dol-
7 lars" and "fifteen thousand dollars", wherever they
8 appear, and inserting in their place the words:— "ten
9 thousand dollars" and "fifty thousand dollars."
