By Mr. Doherty of Medford, petition of the Federation of Massachusetts Consumers for requiring the sale of ice cream by avoirdupois weight. Mercantile Affairs.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT THE SALE OF ICE CREAM SHALL
BE BY AVOIRDUPOIS WEIGHT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 65L of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by section 2 of chapter 341 of the acts of
3 1937, is hereby further amended by inserting after
4 paragraph (f) the following paragraph: —
5 (g) Except when served or sold to be consumed on
6 the premises, ice cream shall not be sold or offered for
7 sale otherwise than by avoirdupois weight.

RESOLVED, That the sum of \$100,000 be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of the purchase of land for the establishment of a national park in the State of California, to be known as the Sequoia National Park, and that the Secretary of the Interior be and is authorized to expend the same in the purchase of such land, and to execute all the necessary orders and contracts in connection therewith, and to report to the Committee on the Interior and Insular Affairs of the Senate the progress of the work done under this resolution.
