AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DESIGNATION OF ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OF BOARDS OF APPEAL UNDER THE MUNICIPAL ZONING LAWS, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in section 1 of chapter 269 of the acts of
3 1933, is hereby amended by striking out the words
4 "mayor or selectmen" in the twenty-fourth line and
5 inserting in place thereof the words: — the chairman,
6 — so that the sentence contained in the nineteenth to
7 the twenty-fourth lines will read as follows: — Such
8 ordinances or by-laws may provide for the appoint-
9 ment in like manner of associate members of the board
10 of appeals; and in case of a vacancy, inability to act,
11 or interest on the part of a member of said board,
12 his place may be taken by an associate member
13 designated by the chairman.
