By Mr. Reilly of Boston, petition of Anthony J. Scalli that the Department of Public Utilities be authorized to purchase from the Metropolitan Transit Authority subways owned by said Authority and relative to the leasing thereof. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF ALL SUBWAYS OWNED BY THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND FOR THE LEASING THEREOF TO SAID AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public utilities, in the name of
2 the commonwealth, shall purchase from the Metro-
3 politan Transit Authority all subways owned by said
4 authority and lease the same to said Authority for its
5 use without charge therefor by the commonwealth.
6 Said purchase shall be effected by the assumption by
7 the commonwealth of all outstanding indebtedness of
8 said Authority incurred by it in the acquisition of said
9 subways.
