AN ACT EXEMPTING NON-PROFIT BOARDING HOMES FOR THE AGED FROM CERTAIN LICENSING REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 71 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 618 of
3 the acts of 1948, is hereby further amended by insert-
4 ing in line 72, after the word "named", the words:—
5 except a non-profit institution.
