By Mr. Telford of Plainville, petition of Clarence F. Telford that the Commissioner of Mental Health be authorized to convey a parcel of land in Foxborough to the Foxboro Fish and Game Association, Inc. Public Welfare.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF MENTAL HEALTH TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE TOWN OF FOXBOROUGH TO THE FOXBORO FISH AND GAME ASSOCIATION, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of mental health, on behalf of
2 the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed
3 to convey by a sufficient deed, in such form and con-
4 taining such provisions binding on the grantee as to
5 said commissioner shall seem best, and approved as
6 to its form by the attorney general, to the Foxboro
7 Fish and Game Association, Inc., of Foxborough, in
8 consideration of dollars, a parcel of land
9 on Walnut Street in said town, containing six acres
10 more or less.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I

Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2

1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.

2. No Person shall be a Representative who shall not, when elected, have seven Years Residence in the United States; and, when elected, shall be, when he takes the Oath or Oaths of Office, at least seven Years of Age.

3. The Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.

4. The House shall choose their Speaker and other Officers; and shall have the sole Power of Impeachment.
