## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OFFICES OF CITY COLLECTOR AND CITY TREASURER OF THE CITY OF REVERE AND TO THE PRESENT INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF CITY COLLECTOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any  
2 general law or any special act relating to the city of  
3 Revere, Clarence R. Borden, the present incumbent of  
4 the office of city collector of said city may if so desig-  
5 nated by the city manager of the city of Revere per-  
6 form the duties of the city treasurer of said city  
7 during the pleasure of the city manager, and such  
8 designation and the performance of such duties of  
9 city treasurer shall in no way diminish, modify or  
10 qualify the tenure of said Clarence R. Borden as city  
11 collector of said city, or any rights, powers, privileges  
12 or benefits of said Clarence R. Borden under chapter  
13 three hundred and fourteen of the acts of nineteen

14 hundred and forty-six and chapter four hundred and  
15 forty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-  
16 eight, or either of them. During such time as said  
17 Clarence R. Borden shall perform the duties of city  
18 treasurer he shall receive such salary, in addition to  
19 his salary as city collector, as the city council of the  
20 city of Revere shall establish by ordinance.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
