AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY ASSESSORS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 93 of the special acts of 1918 is hereby fur-
2 ther amended so as to read as follows: — The appoint-
3 ing officer may appoint any one of the first assistant
4 assessors within the assessing department of the city
5 of Boston, such appointee to be subject to a qualifying
6 civil service examination at the request of the appoint-
7 ing officer.
