By Mr. Fitzgerald of Blackstone, petition of Peter F. Fitzgerald that the Department of Public Works be authorized to eliminate "Dead Man's Curve" on Route 122 in Blackstone and to construct permanent bridges on the "double S" curve. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT TO ELIMINATE "DEAD MAN'S CURVE," SO CALLED, ON ROUTE 122 IN BLACKSTONE, AND TO REPLACE THE TWO BRIDGES ON THE "DOUBLE S" CURVE WITH BRIDGES OF PERMANENT CONSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is authorized and
2 directed to eliminate the "double S" curve, known
3 as "Dead Man's Curve" on Route 122 in Blackstone,
4 and to replace the two bridges there with bridges of
5 permanent construction.
