AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT TO ALLAN A. GILLIS FOR MATERIALS, ALTERATIONS AND EXTRA WORK FURNISHED AND PERFORMED AT THE STATE INFIRMARY AT TEWKSBURY, MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation
2 of the commonwealth, and after an appropriation has
3 been made, there be paid from the state treasury to
4 Allan A. Gillis, as assignee of Allan A. Gillis Construc-
5 tion Company, the sum of seventy-five thousand,
6 two hundred and seventy-three dollars and twenty-
7 seven cents, with interest thereon, for materials,
8 alterations and extra work furnished and performed
9 by said Allan A. Gillis Construction Company in
10 connection with the construction of three buildings
11 at the state infirmary at Tewksbury, Massachusetts,
12 under a contract entered into with the common-
13 wealth dated December first, nineteen hundred and
14 thirty-one.
