In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF BROKERS' OR AGENTS' COMMISSIONS ON CERTAIN POLICIES OF INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The insured named in any policy of insurance issued
2 as the result of an assignment from the Massachusetts
3 rating and inspection bureau may name the insurance
4 agent or broker to whom the insurer shall pay any
5 broker's or agent's commission, and such commission
6 shall be based on the prevailing premium rate.
