AN ACT INCREASING THE TOTAL BENEFITS PAYABLE UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30 of chapter 151A of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 559 of the acts
3 of 1949, is hereby further amended by striking out,
4 in lines 4 and 5, the word "twenty-three" and in-
5 serting in place thereof the word:— twenty-six, —
6 so as to read as follows:— *Section 30.* The total
7 benefits which an unemployed individual may re-
8 ceive during his benefit year shall be an amount
9 equal to thirty per cent of his wages in the base
10 period, or an amount equal to twenty-six times his
11 benefit rate, whichever is the lesser, plus dependency
12 benefits payable under section twenty-nine of this
13 chapter. If such amount includes a fractional part
14 of a dollar, it shall be raised to the next highest dollar.
