AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE RECLAMATION BOARD
TO ERADICATE MOSQUITOES IN THE REVERE MARSHES
WITHOUT CHARGE TO CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provisions of the law to the
2 contrary, the state reclamation board is hereby au-
3 thorized to take such action as may be necessary for
4 the control of mosquitoes in the area known as the
5 Revere marshes in the city of Revere and surrounding
6 cities and towns, without charge to the cities and
7 towns involved.
