*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 The plot of land on the westerly side of Fellsway  
2 East between Pleasant street and Middlesex Fells  
3 parkway in the city of Malden shall be known and  
4 designated as the Monsignor Richard Neagle Memorial  
5 park, and a suitable tablet or marker bearing said  
6 designation shall be erected on said plot of land by  
7 the metropolitan district commission.
