AN ACT CHANGING THE CLASSIFICATION OF CORRECTION OFFICERS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any classification of correction
2 officers in the department of correction made under
3 the provisions of section forty-five of chapter thirty
4 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
5 section one of chapter three hundred and eleven of
6 the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-eight and
7 section forty-six of said chapter, as most recently
8 amended by chapter four hundred and six of the acts
9 of nineteen hundred and forty-nine, the classification
10 of correction officers in the department of correction
11 is hereby changed so that said office or position shall
12 be allocated the salary grade number twenty-six, as
13 appearing in said section forty-six.
