By Mr. Jones of Barnstable, petition of William E. English and others (selectmen of Falmouth) that the discharge of firearms be prohibited on the shores and waters of certain ponds in said town. Conservation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-One.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS ON THE SHORES AND WATERS OF CERTAIN PONDS IN FALMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The discharge of firearms is hereby
2 prohibited on the shores and on the waters of the
3 following ponds located in the town of Falmouth,
4 namely: — Weeks pond, Shivericks pond, Siders pond
5 also known as Fresh pond, Salt pond and Oyster pond.

1 SECTION 2. For each and every violation of this
2 act there shall be a fine of not less than ten dollars
3 nor more than fifty dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
