RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO EXAMINE THE STRUCTURE OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission,
2 established by chapter seventy-five of the Resolves
3 of nineteen hundred and forty-nine and the scope and
4 membership increased by chapters thirty-six, seventy-
5 six and eighty-four of nineteen hundred and fifty is
6 hereby revived and continued. Said commission
7 shall make a report to the general court of the results
8 of its study and its recommendations, together with
9 drafts of legislation necessary to give effect to the
10 same, by filing the same with the clerk of the house
11 of representatives on or before the thirty-first day of
12 December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one.

13 For the purposes of this resolve, said commission
14 may expend the unexpended balance of the amount
15 appropriated by item 0261 of section two of chapter
16 eight hundred and twenty-five, and in addition, such
17 sums as may be appropriated therefor.
