AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE OF THE
PRESENT INCUMBENT OF THE POSITION OF SMOKE
INSPECTOR IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH
OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The incumbent of the position of
2 smoke inspector in the department of public health
3 of the city of Holyoke on the effective date of this
4 act shall continue to be employed in said position,
5 and may be removed therefrom by the appointing
6 authority only for cause and after a hearing and a
7 decision by the appointing authority. Said decision
8 may be appealed from to the board of aldermen
9 within five days after the giving of notice thereof by
10 the appointing authority, and the board of aldermen
11 shall give a hearing and decision thereon within
12 thirty days after the filing of a request for a hearing.
13 The decision of the board of aldermen may, within
14 thirty days after notice to the employee of the decision
15 of the board of aldermen, be appealed from to the
16 district court subject to and in accordance with the
17 provisions of section forty-five of chapter thirty-one
18 of the General Laws to the same extent as if the
19 position were classified under said chapter thirty-one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by the board of aldermen of said city,
3 subject to the provisions of its charter, but not other-
4 wise.
