The committee on Education, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 259) of Joseph F. McEvoy, Jr., relative to providing higher educational opportunities for children of Massachusetts men and women who died in the armed forces of the United States or as a result of such service, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1029) of The American Legion Inc. (Department of Massachusetts) for higher educational opportunities for children of deceased veterans, report the accompanying order (House, No. 2398).

Ordered, That the committee on Education be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court to study the subject matter of current House Document numbered 259, relative to providing higher educational opportunities for children of Massachusetts men and women who died in the armed forces of the United States or as a result of such service; and of current House Document numbered 1029, relative to higher educational opportunities for children of deceased veterans. Said committee may travel within and without the Commonwealth and may expend for clerical and other expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
