### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE TIME OF HOLDING THE BIENNIAL ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF SAUGUS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 17 of the acts of  
2 1947 is hereby amended by striking out the first sen-  
3 tence and inserting in place thereof the following:—  
4 Upon the acceptance of this act by the town of Saugus,  
5 as hereinafter provided, beginning with the year nine-  
6 teen hundred and fifty-one, the regular town election  
7 of said town for the purpose of electing town officers,  
8 including town meeting members, and for the submis-  
9 sion of questions to the voters of the town if required  
10 to be submitted thereat shall be held biennially on the  
11 Tuesday next after the first Monday in November in  
12 every odd-numbered year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by a majority of the registered voters of

3 the town of Saugus voting thereon at a special town  
 4 election called by the selectmen of said town not less  
 5 than sixty days prior to November sixth in the current  
 6 year. Upon the election and qualification of the town  
 7 officers, including town meeting members, the term of  
 8 office of the town officers including town meeting mem-  
 9 bers then existing shall terminate.
