RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE WORK OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSOLIDATING AND ARRANGING THE SPECIAL LAWS RELATING TO THE CITY OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission es-  
2 tablished by chapter twenty-eight of the resolves of  
3 nineteen hundred and fifty, and revived and contin-  
4 ued by a resolve passed in the current year, shall, in  
5 the course of its work, consider the subject matter of  
6 current senate document numbered 33, relative to es-  
7 tablishing in the city of Boston the office of budget  
8 and personnel director and defining his powers and  
9 duties.
