RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION
AND STUDY OF THE COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO STUDY
AND REVISE THE LAWS RELATING TO PUBLIC WELFARE.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission es-
2 tablished by chapter fifty-seven of the resolves of
3 nineteen hundred and forty-seven, revived and con-
4 tinued by chapter forty-seven of the resolves of
5 nineteen hundred and forty-nine, revived and con-
6 tinued by chapter sixty-three of the resolves of nine-
7 teen hundred and fifty, and further revived and
8 continued by chapter _____ of the resolves of
9 the current year, for the purpose of studying and
10 revising the laws relating to public welfare, shall, in
11 making its study, consider the subject matter of
12 current senate document numbered 453, relative to
13 providing for financial assistance to needy individuals
14 eighteen years of age or older who are permanently
15 and totally disabled; of current senate document
16 numbered 462, relative to the problems of the aging;
17 of current senate order relative to the conduct and
18 procedure of the division of child guardianship in the
19 department of public welfare; of current house
20 document numbered 320, relative to the expenditure
21 of state funds by cities and towns in their programs
22 for aid to dependent children and aid to the aged; of

23 current house document numbered 321, relative to the
24 problems of institutional care for the helpless aged;
25 and of current house document numbered 411, rela-
26 tive to the problems of the aging.
