### RESOLVE VALIDATING THE ACTS OF DOROTHEA E. HIGGINS OF HOLYOKE AS A NOTARY PUBLIC.

1 *Resolved*, That the acts of Dorothea E. Higgins of  
2 Holyoke as a notary public between June twenty-  
3 ninth, nineteen hundred and forty-five and May  
4 twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, both  
5 dates inclusive, in so far as the same may have been  
6 invalid by reason of the fact that, upon the change of  
7 her name from Dorothea E. Torno, she failed to re-  
8 register under her new name and pay to the state  
9 secretary a fee of one dollar as required by section  
10 thirteen of chapter thirty of the General Laws, are  
11 hereby confirmed and made valid.
