AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICES OR POSITIONS OF SECRETARY,  
CHIEF ACCOUNTANT AND SUPERVISING RACING INSPECTOR  
OF THE STATE RACING COMMISSION UNDER CIVIL SERVICE  
LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 The offices or positions of secretary, chief account-  
2 ant and supervising racing inspector of the state racing  
3 commission shall, upon the effective date of this act,  
4 become subject to the civil service laws and rules, and  
5 the incumbents of said offices or positions on July  
6 first in the current year shall be deemed to be per-  
7 manently appointed thereto without serving any  
8 probationary period, and their tenure of office shall be  
9 unlimited, subject, however, to said laws and rules;  
10 provided, that said incumbents pass qualifying ex-  
11 aminations to which they shall be subjected by the  
12 division of civil service.
