## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

### AN ACT TO PROVIDE FLEXIBILITY IN THE PAYMENT OF UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subsection (a) of section 23 of chapter 151A of the General  
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 530 of the acts of  
3 1955, is hereby further amended by striking out the last sentence  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — No  
5 benefits shall be or become payable during said waiting period;  
6 thereafter benefits shall be payable weekly and shall be paid  
7 weekly; provided, however, that whenever, in the judgment of  
8 the director, the public interest would be benefited thereby,  
9 benefits may be paid on a bi-weekly basis.
